A Note from the CEO

Dear friends of KSF,

From August 27 thru September 4th, 2020, using my own funds, I went to Haïti and brought over 400 items for the kids, our students who attend the Kedner Stiven Foundation School. Several KSF members residing in Haïti were present. Miss Tourism, Sainte Claire Ainée Phanord helped me distribute over 200 COVID-19 masks and other hygiene items. I met with KSF schoolteachers. During my visit at the school, I asked that everyone stopped beating students, which is considered physical punishment. It was on August 28, 2020.

There was a press conference. Radio Vision 2000 sent Jacques Stevenson Saint Louis, Jean Louis Milien, Velima Judex, Velima Wildi, Milka Etienne to interview at Decameron Hotel, formerly known as Indigo Royal Caribbean. Marie Ange Charles (a KSF member) was present during the interview. See picture below.

The trip was a success.

Back to the States in September 2020, the Foundation sent to the school a box that contained school supplies, wall clocks, books in English (and many other items) for the administrative office. I am in constant contact with staff members in Haiti.

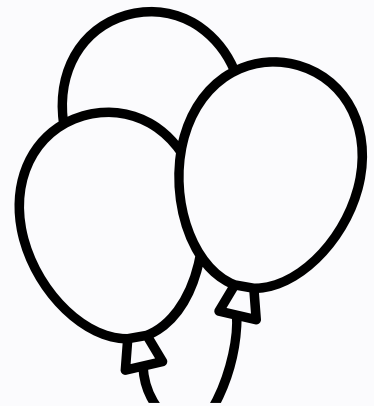
